In this key role, you will be responsible for:

- Interacting with senior management and Board members of regulated insurance entities and groups, which includes coordinating and executing on-site visits of these insurance enterprises.
- Reviewing documents, reports, and recommendations from Analytical staff on regulatory or operational matters, and where appropriate determining the appropriate course of action.
- Providing advice and senior level technical support to regulatory or operational teams relative to the Authority's statutory responsibilities.
- Providing first line leadership to a team of Senior Analysts.
- Motivating and monitoring performance and overseeing the development of direct reports in the achievement of departmental objectives.
- Performing other related work and special projects as assigned by management.

This position requires a proven technical and business background:

- A university degree in actuarial science, finance or accounting from a recognized institution and a professional designation (CPA, CA, CFA, CPCU), etc. or international equivalent);
